-  Top 10% will receive the GOLD LEAF Certificate and a book grant
-  10-20% will receive the SILVER LEAF Certificate
-  20-30% will receive the BRONZE LEAF Certificate

- ◆ Enable sharing of Ph.D. and supervisors experience on scientific research
- ◆ Enlarge Ph.D. network with research laboratories and companies
- ◆ Encourage the presentation of Ph.D. student research topics
